# **Stability Spotlight**

Our connections in our ten CommUNITY Schools have created more connectivity to our school social workers. One social worker connected us to a neighbor who'd lost her job as a data analyst, and she'd not yet found a comparable job with equivalent pay. She'd gotten herself deep in debt with many credit cards, attempting to stay afloat. We provided for her basic need of food while also connecting her to multiple resources to help her save on expenses, as well as connecting her to Consumer Credit Counseling to try to consolidate her debt. In the 2000s, Northside Neighborhood House expanded its educational offerings. The afterschool program was extended from serving K-5th to including K-8th grade. The NNH also collaborated with ReStart on an adult education GED program. During this time,

Ansel Peak retired as Executive Director, and Rachel Gammon was appointed to the role. One of the lasting legacies of the 2000s was the establishment of the annual Not So Silent Auction, which has since become a cherished tradition, raising support for the NNH's vital work in the community.
